Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese join together to obtain an olfactory bouquet and a structure in which different nuances and intense aromas can be found.

Ruby color fading to garnet, wide and intense aroma with hints of **wild berries, vanilla, cocoa and tobacco** blend in a powerful structure, with well-articulated tannins and a long-lasting ending that suggests an aging potential worthy of great red wines .

The label is inspired by the abbey of Benedictine monks who around the year 1000 gave the town its name, Abbadia di Montepulciano, where our company resides.
